



Isolation/Quarantine Procedure

Effective August 20, 2021

SUSPECTED COVID-19: An unvaccinated student exhibiting multiple symptoms of COVID-19 at school will be sent home. The student may return with a negative COVID-19 test, or 10 days from the onset of symptoms.

COVID-19 POSITIVE: If a student or staff member is COVID-19 positive they are to isolate for 10 days regardless of vaccination status.

COVID-19 CONTACT: A contact is defined as someone who was closer than six feet to the infected person for at least 15 minutes during a 24-hour period beginning 48 hours before the infected person developed symptoms through the time the infected person began quarantine.

Because Nordonia follows COVID-19 prevention protocols (hand washing, disinfecting, etc.), **contacts are not required to quarantine** if:

1. The contact has been fully vaccinated; **OR**
2. The contact was masked **AND** at least 3 feet of physical distance was in place **AND** the contact is not exhibiting multiple symptoms of COVID-19.

QUARANTINE: If a student or staff member is required to quarantine as a result of exposure to COVID-19:

1. The quarantine will last for at least 10 days since the date of last exposure
2. The quarantined individual should have a negative viral (PCR or antigen) test collected on or after day five.
3. The quarantined individual should watch for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 for 10 days.
4. If any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 are observed the individual should consider consulting their physician
5. During the period of quarantine, the exposed individual is advised to stay home and away from others as much as possible.
