WELCOME TO THE HELLO, OLENTANGY STUDENT PODCAST CHALLENGE!

We're inviting Olentangy students to create a podcast - independently, or with the help of a parent, teacher, or mentor - for a chance to have their work featured on the district's Hello, Olentangy podcast.



STUDENT PODCAST CHALLENGE!

CHALLENGE: Create, record and submit a podcast that utilizes one of the following prompts:

- How might we flourish in our community?
- What is it like to be a student in 2022?
- What does learning look and feel like?
- Tell us your story or a story about you

DUE DATE: November 29, 2022

SUBMISSION: Podcast episodes should be three to five minutes long. Use this [entry form](#) to submit your original podcast recording.

WINNERS: Winners will be announced at the beginning of December, and featured on the *Hello, Olentangy* podcast.

One winner will be selected from each grade level group (K - 5, 6 - 8, 9 - 12).



STUDENT PODCAST CHALLENGE!

HOW IT WORKS: Students create and record a podcast independently, with a class, with an extracurricular group, with friends, etc. Students may utilize help from parents and caregivers, mentors, and/or teachers if they choose.

Podcasts will be judged based on their originality, the storytelling techniques, if they have a clear message, and the ability to captivate an audience. Winning podcasts will be featured on the Hello, Olentangy district podcast.

We don't expect students to be experts - most will be putting a podcast episode together for the very first time. This is about learning new skills in a fun way. Below are some resources students and teachers can utilize in creating a podcast episode:

PARAMETERS FOR ELIGIBILITY: All recordings must be original and cannot contain work from other podcasts, organizations or businesses. If you would like to include an intro or outro, make sure all sounds or music follow copyright law and/or are purchased from an authorized site. By submitting an entry, you affirm that you own all the rights to any and all musical content in your submission. Podcast recordings cannot be derogatory, offensive, threatening, defamatory, or contain any content that is inappropriate, indecent, sexual, profane, slanderous, discriminatory in any way, or that promotes hatred or harm against any group or person, or otherwise does not comply with the theme and spirit of the challenge.



STUDENT STEP SHEET

STEP 1: Select the prompt your podcast will follow:

- How might we flourish in our community?
- What is it like to be a student in 2022?
- What does learning look and feel like?
- Tell us your story or a story about you

STEP 2: Create an outline or script to communicate your message within three to five minutes.

STEP 3: Record your podcast using anything from a smartphone/tablet to a computer/microphone setup. Some schools have recording equipment you may use, please ask your teacher or the front office for how to request the use of school equipment.

STEP 4: When your recording is complete and you confirm you have followed the parameters and instructions for the challenge, submit your final recording from your Google Drive using this [entry form](#) by November 29, 2022.
